LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT	English B2 German B2	We expect a profound knowledge of English (B2) from all students! Basic knowledge of German is strongly recommended, as a lot of lectures are held in German. Dept. of Graphics and Advertising and Language Arts as well as Dept. of Studies in Art and Culture: German knowledge level B1-B2 is obligatory! We recommend attending a German course before and during the exchange in Vienna. A free German course is offered by our Student Union.
